DEMANDING MOSHIACH

The first time that the Jewish People observed Passover in the desert, there were some Jews who were impure and, so, were unable to partake of the Pascal lamb. These men complained to Moshe, "Why should we lose out?" Moshe asked G-d what to do, and G-d replied that they should bring the sacrifice at the same time the following month. (See Numbers 9:1-12)

The holiday of Pesach Sheini originated from the demands of a few Jews who did not want to be deprived of the mitzvah of Pesach. Because of their sincere request, G-d granted them a second chance.

From this event, we learn that we must not be complacent in exile. We are being deprived of not one but hundreds of mitzvos. When we sincerely demand of G-d, "Why should we be deprived?", He will surely bring Moshiach, and we will be able to properly fulfill all the commandments once more.

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
