MOSHIACH: PERSON, TEACHER, AND KING

FEAR OF G-D

*Ruler over man shall be the righteous, he who rules in the fear of G-d.
(Shmuel II 23:3)*

*Kingship is inherited, so long as the heir is a fitting replacement in both wisdom and fear of G d. If he has fear of G-d, but not wisdom, he may serve as king. But one without fear of Heaven, even if he is very wise, may not serve as king or in any position of leadership.
(Mishneh Torah Hil. Melachim 1:9)*

Although the unique qualities of Moshiach involve his role as a teacher and prophet, the essence of his rulership is his fear of G-d. A king's authority comes from being G-d's servant and messenger. The more that he submits to G d's authority, the more that authority transfers to him and his kingship.

In the same way, our ability to transform the world and bring Moshiach depends on the depth of our commitment and dedication to a higher authority.
