HEAVENLY OPINIONS, EARTHLY DECISIONS

When Moshe ascended to receive the Torah, G-d told Moshe forty-nine reasons to render each legal item impure and forty-nine reasons to render it pure. Moshe asked, "Master of the world, how will I clarify these matters?" G-d answered, "Follow the majority."

In the way the Torah exists above in G-d's wisdom, many conflicting opinions exist at the same time, and all of them are true. Now, we can only see truth one way at a time, so we must follow the majority. When Moshiach comes, we will begin to understand the Torah as it is above and see the truth in all of the opinions. This will allow greater variation and flexibility because we will be able to apply the law to fit each person's situation.

Even now, however, we must not rely only on asking our rabbis. We must strive to learn and understand the Torah so that we can apply its lessons to even the most subtle and individual aspects of our lives.

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
