FULFILLING COMMANDMENTS WITHOUT OBEYING THEM

The commandments will be nullified when Moshiach comes, but the laws will not be nullified when Moshiach comes.

(Talmud Yerushalmi, Megillah 1:5; Sdei Chemed 40:218)

When Moshiach comes, we will understand the inner reasons for the commandments. Because of this, we will want to practice the Torah's laws and will no longer need to be commanded to do so.

This is comparable to an adult. When an adult acts appropriately, it is because he wants to. He does not need anyone to watch him or make him do the right thing.

Likewise, with the coming of Moshiach, we will achieve a certain degree of independence and will use this freedom for the right things. However, we will only be granted this freedom once we have reached the proper level of maturity.
