MOSHIACH: PERSON, TEACHER, AND KING

STRONG AND WEALTHY

*The Holy One, blessed be He, only rests His prophetic spirit upon one who is strong, wealthy, wise, and humble.
(Talmud, Nedarim 38a.)*

As a prophet and a king, Moshiach must be strong and wealthy. Though wisdom and humility are the essential qualities required to be a prophet and a king, certain physical qualities help a person meet these roles.
