HIDDEN GOOD

Although the Previous Rebbe was informed of his release on the 12th of Tammuz, the required paperwork was not complete until the next day, the 13th of Tammuz. On this day, the Rebbe was escorted in great honor out of exile, and he was allowed to leave the Soviet Union and travel to America, where he continued strengthening Judaism in the New World and around the world at large.

The imprisonment of the Previous Rebbe was a torturous nightmare. Yet, in the end, it was transformed into something positive; it led to the Rebbe's freedom and relocation to America, where he was able to redouble his efforts and accomplish more than ever. His release also began a shift in the Soviet attitude toward religious freedom, culminating in the fall of the Iron Curtain. In the end, the Soviet Government actually aided the Rebbe and, even today, supports the activities of his followers.

This is the idea of Moshiach, revealing the hidden good. We can accomplish this by serving G-d on two levels, the hidden and the revealed. We must serve G-d with our body and with our hidden soul, with action and with intellectual understanding, by studying Torah law and Jewish mysticism, and by giving charity with joy. These activities will help us reveal the hidden good and transform exile into Redemption.
