## MOSHIACH IN MINUTES

When we speak about Moshiach, one might think that the subject is not relevant. But according to Torah law, this is not so. For instance, there is an opinion that states that a kohen may not drink wine at any time because an intoxicated person is forbidden to serve in the Temple, and the Temple will speedily be rebuilt.

The Talmud explains that there are two ways that intoxication can wear off: either through sleep or by waiting eighteen to twenty-four minutes. Consequently, according to Torah law, Moshiach can arrive and the Temple can be rebuilt in less than 23 minutes and 59 seconds. Therefore, a kohen always must be ready to immediately resume the Temple service.
