MOSHIACH: PERSON, TEACHER, AND KING

A TRUE KING

Once David was anointed king, he acquired the crown of kingship forever. Afterwards, kingship belongs to him and his descendants forever.

(Mishneh Torah, Hil. Melachim 1:10)

King Moshiach represents G-d's Essence. Although he will perfect the world, this is not the purpose of his kingship. Rather, Moshiach's quality as king essentially reflects G-d's Kingship. This was the crown of kingship that G-d gave to David and his descendants.

Every Jew has been chosen by G-d to represent Him in the world by studying and knowing His Torah for its own sake. When we study for a particular purpose, we limit our scope and understanding to that area. When we study the entire Torah simply to know G-d, we grasp His Essence. By learning in this way, we become proper representatives of G-d and prepare the way for the ultimate representative—King Moshiach.
