THE TORAH OF MOSHIACH

SO SENSITIVE

*In the time of Moshiach, the law will follow the school of Shamai.
(Mikdash Melech, Zohar I 17b)*

In the times of the Talmud, two great schools emerged: the more lenient school of Hillel and the more stringent school of Shamai. Our sages tell us that the students of Shamai had a deeper understanding of the Torah. Yet, in almost all matters of Torah law, we rule like the students of Hillel because they were the majority.

The students of Shamai were stringent because their deep understanding of halacha made them sensitive to even the slightest negative potential of any action. To avoid this, the laws were designed to protect the spiritual core of the law. When Moshiach comes, everyone will be attuned to an increased level of understanding; therefore, the majority will rule like Shamai.

As we approach the time of Moshiach, many stringencies have become common practice. In addition, many customs have been adopted that are based on the teachings of Kabbalah and Chassidus.

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
