SEEING G-DLINESS

Moshe merited to “see” G-dliness. He wanted to share this Divine perception with the Jewish People. However, G-d prevented him, and, instead, he was only allowed to teach us explanations. In a sense, this is like “hearing” G-dliness. Our sages explain that G-d wants us to have the opportunity to work. If Moshe were allowed to share his own ability to perceive G-dliness, learning Torah would have required no effort on our part.

When Moshiach comes, however, we will merit seeing G-dliness. Therefore, Moshiach will be able to teach us much more than even Moshe.
